LOST PORTS EXHIBITION

Wales has a long, indented coastline, almost 870 miles in length. Farming and industry gave rise to trade, and whilst some of that trade flowed eastwards over Offa's Dyke, much of it also went by sea and river, in many cases from locations where it is difficult to imagine a port today. This exhibition recalls some of those lost ports. It was first produced by the Swansea Waterfront Museum for 2016 Year of the Sea and this is its first showing elsewhere.
